Patrick McCarthy hanshi, 9th Dan June 15th/16th 2019 in Dresden (Germany)

Patrick McCarthy sensei – martial arts expert, outstanding competitor, karate historian, book author (e.g. "Bubishi – The Bible of Karate") and seminar instructor of worldwide renown – is going to teach a fifth international seminar in Dresden (Germany), 20 years after his first seminar in Germany. Martial artists of any style are welcome to experience his in-depth understandding of kata bunkai as he is going to teach Aragaki Sōchin (karate) and Tokumine no kon (bōjutsu). A learning opportunity you would not want to miss! Versions of Sōchin can be found in the curricula of quite a few karate styles, e.g. Shōrin ryū, Shitō ryū or Shōtōkan ryū. In 1938 Mabuni Kenwa introduced his version of Sōchin to the general karate public in Nakasone Genwa's compilation "Karatedō Taikan" and

gave credit to Master Niigaki/Aragaki as its original source. McCarthy sensei's Aragaki no Sochin is linked to this tradition via Richard Kim sensei and will be the topic of our seminar on Saturday. It was also Richard Kim sensei who taught Tokumine no kon to Patrick McCarthy first. This bo kata was preserved or even created by Kyan Chōtoku and therefore examplifies a rather unusual transmission line in Okinawan kobudō. His interest in the staff techniques of a man called Tokumine pēchin lead Kyan to Yaeyama island in the beginning of the 20th century. Legend has it that he arrived shortly after Tokumine had passed away, but Kyan was lucky enough to learn the sought-after techniques from an acquaintance of Tokumine. McCarthy sensei will teach this form and its application on Sunday.
